Emergency Regulation to Adapt the Michigan Interim order to Ban Baiting of Deer.

WHEREAS, the Little River Band Tribal Council, in the Natural Resource Commission Ordinance (NRCO) #03-500-01, delegated to the Natural Resource Commission (Commission) emergency powers; and

WHEREAS, the emergency powers authorize the Commission, pursuant to the NRCO, section 6.02e, "to adopt, when deemed necessary by the Commission, such emergency regulations not to exceed 90 days in duration, including, but not limited to, restrictions on seasons, bag or creel limits, or method of harvest, as may be necessary to protect fish, wildlife, and plant populations, or other natural resources"; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has deemed that there is the need to enact emergency regulations on all parcels of land, including Gathering Grounds, collectively under the jurisdiction of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians ("LRBOI") governing all Tribal members for all activities including, but not limited to, baiting of deer;

WHEREAS, the Commission has deemed that any deer baiting or baiting such as *a substance composed of grains, minerals, salt, fruit, vegetables, hay or any other food material, whether natural or manufactured, which may lure, entice or attract Deer* on lands within the jurisdiction of the LRBOI is prohibited.

THE NATURAL RESOURCE COMMISSION FURTHER RESOLVES that this Emergency Regulation shall expire on December 3, 2008 or if the ban is lifted by the State of Michigan before this date it will expire concurrently with the State.

Certificate of Adoption

This Resolution was adopted by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Natural Resources Commission at an emergency meeting held at the Tribal Council conference room, 375 River Street, Manistee, MI, on September 3, 2008 by a vote of 5 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 absent, and 0 abstentions; a quorum of the Commission being present for such vote.
