Resolution # 09-1014-295

Acceptance of ARRA grant/contract funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Services, for LRBOI Tribal Health Clinic renovations in a total amount of \$320,573.00 and approving a modification in the FY2009 operating budget MB-2009-45 as specified in this resolution

WHEREAS, the status of the *Gaá Čhíng Ziibi Daáwaa Aníshinaábek* (Little River Band of Ottawa Indians) as a sovereign and Treaty-making power is confirmed in numerous treaties, from agreements with the initial colonial powers on this land, to various treaties with the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is descended from, and is the political successor to, the Grand River Ottawa Bands, signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) with the United States, as reaffirmed by federal law in P.L. 103-324, enacted in 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted amendments to the Constitution on April 26, 2004, which became effective upon approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on May 13, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under Article IV, Section 7(a) to provide for the public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Constitution, has the power to manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tribe and to appropriate such funds for the benefit of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, the acceptance of grant funds from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Indian Health Services in a total amount of \$320,573.00 for Tribal Health Clinic renovations will require a modification of the Operating Budget for Fiscal Year 2009.

WHEREAS, while the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Indian Health Services combined funding from two separate projects (BE9LR020C6 & BE9LR021C6) in the respective amounts of \$276,000 and \$44,573 to arrive at the total award of \$320,573.00 for LRBOI Tribal Health Clinic renovations, there remains a need to separately track/report on the two overall project components (as identified): as a result, two program/fund numbers have been assigned to clarify project activities and the expenditure of related funding.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves a modification to the Operating Budget for the Tribal Government for Fiscal Year 2009 to include grant funds in a total amount of \$320,573.00 from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Indian Health Services. The above indicated contract funds are shall be allocated as follows:


