RESOLUTION NO. #00-0424-07

RATIFYING CONSULTING CONTRACT WITH JAMES

McCLURKEN & ASSOCIATES FOR ETHNOHISTORICAL WORK AND

AGREEING TO A LIMITED WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY IN SUCH CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a federally recognized tribe, as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994, with property rights secured to it under the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491) and the 1855 Treaty of Detroit (11 Stat. 621); and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is descended from, and is the political successor to, Grand River Ottawa Bands which were signatories of the 1836 Treaty of Washington (7 Stat. 491), as reaffirmed under P.L. 103-324, enacted on September 21, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians reserved certain territorial rights and other attributes of sovereignty under the 1836 Treaty. These treaty based rights were confirmed, in part, by <u>United States v. Michigan</u>, 471 F.Supp 192 (W.D. Mich. 1979); *affirmed*, 653 F.2d 277 (6th Cir. 1981); *certiorari denied*, 454 U.S. 1124, 102 S.Ct. 971 (1981), and reaffirmed by P.L. 103-324 section 5, and are protected by the United States Constitution (Art. 1, §8, cl. 3 and Art. 6, cl. 2); and

WHEREAS, the maintenance and preservation of the Tribe's treaty rights is a critical priority of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Tribal Council to protect Tribal members and Tribal property; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema, in consultation with the Tribal Attorney, negotiated a Consulting Contract with James M. McClurken & Associates to perform ethnohistorical and historical research related to rights reserved under the 1836 Treaty; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that negotiation and execution of such an agreement is in the best interests of the Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema, Robert Guenthardt, to negotiated and execute a Consulting Contract with James M. McClurken & Associates, upon the recommendation of the Tribal Attorney.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council, in authorizing the execution of such Consulting Contract, expressly agrees to a limited waiver of sovereign immunity, and consents to the jurisdiction of the Tribal Courts of the Little River Ottawa, for the limited purpose of permitting enforcement of such Consulting Agreement by James M. McClurken & Associates.
