Authorizing Use of the Tribal Seal in Connection with Tribal Pow-Wow 2000

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has enacted a Tribal Seal Ordinance, Ordinance No. 96-100-01, as amended, which adopts a Seal for the Tribal Government and which regulates and restricts the use or facsimiles, reproductions or impressions of the Tribal Seal; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.03 of the Tribal Seal Ordinance prescribes limitations on the commercial use of the Tribal Seal or like reproductions in connection with official functions of the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Pow Wow Committee of the Cultural Preservation Committee has requested authorization to use the Tribal Seal on T-shirts to be sold at and in support of the Tribal Pow Wow 2000; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.03 of the Tribal Seal Ordinance requires that commercial use of the Tribal Seal, with or without the wording associated with Seal, be authorized by the Tribal Council.

NOW THEREFOR IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Pow Wow Committee to use the Tribal Seal, without the wording associated with the Seal, on T-shirts for sale in connection with the Tribal Pow Wow 2000, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The Pow Wow Committee shall account for the specific number of shirts acquired for sale in connection with the Pow Wow;
- (b) The vendor selected to produce the T-shirts shall obtain a permit to do business with the Tribe from Tribal Ogema, which permit authorizes the

(c) The Pow Wow Committee shall account for all expenses and income associated with the purchase and sale of shirts bearing the Tribal Seal and all profits from the sale of items shall turned over to the Tribe's general fund to off-set costs associated with the Pow Wow.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION

I do hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly presented and adopted by the Tribal Council with <u>7</u> FOR, <u>O</u> AGAINST, <u>C</u> ABSENT, and <u>O</u> ABSTAINING, at a Regular Session of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council held on June 10, 2000, at the Little River Band Community Center in Manistee, Michigan, with a quorum being present for such vote.
