APPROVING BUDGET MODIFICATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2000 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE LITTLE RIVER CASINO RESORT (RESORT) TO REFLECT A 2000 BUDGET AMENDMENT OF \$56,000.00 TO **INCREASE EMPLOYER SHARE OF MONTHLY MEDICAL AND DENTAL** PREMIUMS FOR DEPENDENT COVERAGE FROM 50% TO 100%.

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians (Tribe) is the owner of the Little River Casino Resort; and

WHEREAS, the enterprise has expressed concern for the disparity of benefits of Little River Casino Resort employees and the benefits of the competition; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that increases in employee benefits will be helpful in the recruitment and retention of enterprise employees; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Casino Resort developed the above indicated employee

WHEREAS, the Business Board/of the Little River Casino Resort has reviewed and approved the increase in PTO days in the 2nd year of employment from 15 to 18 days. Employer share of Monthly medical/dental premiums NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little Difference of medical and dent is medical and dental coverage from 50% to 100% effective October 1, 2000 and the necessary budget amendment associated with this change in Little River Casino Resort employee benefits.
