WHEREAS, it is anticipated that increases in employee benefits will be helpful in the recruitment and retention of enterprise employees; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Casino Resort developed the above indicated employee benefit to partially address these issues; and

WHEREAS, the Business Board of the Little River Casino Resort has reviewed and with addition a WHEREAS, the Business Board of the Little River Casino Resort has reviewed and approved the increase in PTO days in the 2nd year of employment from 15 to 18 days. Letter incentive de
