APPROVING STATEMENT OF FEES AND EXPENSES FOR JUNE AND JULY 2000 FOR PAYMENT TO DRUMMOND, WOODSUM & MacMAHON

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is the governing body of the Tribe, pursuant to the Tribe's Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, did approve a Special Counsel Contract with Drummond, Woodsum & MacMahon, for a period commencing June 1, 2000, pursuant to Article IV of the Tribe's Constitution and Bylaws,; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Attorney has reviewed the statement of legal services performed and expenses incurred by Drummond, Woodsum & MacMahon during the months of June and July 2000 and has recommended payment of such fees and expenses; and

WHEREAS the Tribal Attorney has represented that the amounts billed for fees and expenses are reasonable, that amounts billed are within the amount allowed under the Contract, and that funds are available to pay such charges.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves for payment the following amounts for the month of June 2000:
