Resolution No. 00- 1212 - 04.

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Indian Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324; and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998 which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council pursuant to Article IV, 7 of the Constitution has the power to enact ordinances and resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has determined that it would best serve the Native American population of Michigan with the Community Services Block Grant funding if the funding were to be applied for and distributed through the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan of which, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a member Tribe.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by Resolution does hereby authorize the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, Inc. to apply for the Community Services Block Grant Funds from the Of Community Services, United States Department of Health and Human Services for fiscal year 2001-2002.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Little River Band authorizes Sharon L. Teeple, Executive Director of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan to negotiate and implement the financial award on behalf of the member Tribes of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan.
