### **Resolution No. 00- 1212 - 09**

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Indian Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324; and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998 which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary of Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council pursuant to Article IV, 7 of the Constitution has the power to enact ordinances and resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has determined that it is the best interest for the health and well being of the Native Americans served by the Tribal Clinic Office to submit an application to the Bemidji Area Indian Health Service to secure Tribal Medical Equipment for said facility.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution does hereby authorize the Department of Grants and Contracts to apply for the Availability of Tribal Medical Equipment Funds for Fiscal Year 2001.




CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION
