Resolution No. #01-0110_0

Authorizing the Tribal Ogema, or in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker to Execute a Contract Retaining Bay Shore Construction to Provide Owner's Representative Services in Connection with the Casino Expansion Project and Community Water/Wastewater Systems Project

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe is entitled to the protections and benefits accorded federally-recognized Indian tribes under federal law, including those under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act of 1988 (25 U.S.C. §2701 <u>et seq.</u>)(hereinafter "IGRA"), which permits Indian tribes to operate Class II and III gaming activities on lands held in trust for the Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that the development of the permanent casino/resort and community water/wastewater facilities is in the best, long-term interests of the Tribe and its members; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to a Request for Proposal process, selected Bay Shore Construction to provide Owner's Representative services to represent the Tribe in connection with the design/construction the permanent Casino/Resort and the community water/wastewater systems; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe and Bay Shore Construction have previously entered into a Letter Agreement, authorizing Bay Shore Construction to undertake certain preliminary tasks associated with the desired services, pending negotiation of a comprehensive contract; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, through its attorneys, and Bay Shore Construction have reached agreement of a form of contract addressing the comprehensive services to be provided by Bay Shore; and Resolution No. #01-0110-<u>C</u> Page two

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 5 (a)(4) and Article V, Section 5(a)(3) and (8) of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Ogema, or in his/her absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, is authorized to represent the Tribe in its relations with other organizations and manage the economic affairs/enterprises of the Tribe, in a manner consistent with the Tribal Constitution and resolutions of the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (b) of the Constitution, has the power to authorize and ratify agreements and contracts negotiated by the Tribal Ogema; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that execution of a contract with Bay Shore Construction will advance important Tribal purposes and tribal business enterprises.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema, or in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, to execute a contract with Bay Shore Construction Company, to perform owner's representative services in connection with the design and construction of the permanent Casino Resort and community water/wastewater projects being considered.
