## Authorizing Payment of Fees to DeVere Construction Company for Planning and Design Services Provided to Renovate the Downtown Offices of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Administration has a critical need for additional office space to accommodate the development of Tribal programs anticipated in the coming months; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Administration did approve an appropriation for costs associated with planning and design services necessary to renovate the Downtown Office building; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe retained DeVere Construction to develop the renovation plans and design documents, construction budget estimates, and receive and review bids for renovation work at the Downtown Office Building, and

WHEREAS, DeVere Construction Company has completed planning and design services for the renovations to the Downtown Office Building,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves payment to DeVere Construction Company in the amount of \$ 37,800 for planning and design services necessary to renovate the Downtown Office building.
