Resolution No. # 01-0214-06

Expanding the Responsibilities of the Construction Management Team for the New Casino to Include the Water and Wastewater Treatment Systems Development

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k <u>et</u> <u>seq.</u>)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe had determined that developing and constructing a new casino will benefit the Tribe and result in increased revenue; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that increased revenue will result in additional funding for government programs protecting and enhancing the health, safety and welfare of the Tribe and its membership; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that a Construction Management Team is necessary to manage the New Casino construction project to allow for the project to be completed in a timely and financially responsible manner; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and Tribal membership has determined that restoration of the Tribe's historic reservation land base and other lands within the Tribe's historic territory is a critical priority;
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that it is critical to expand its economic endeavors and address the needs for tribal housing on its current land holdings;
- WHEREAS, this expansion needs the appropriate infrastructure, including a water system and wastewater treatment system to be built in order to fulfill these needs;
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that the Construction Management Team is necessary to manage the development of the water and waste water treatment systems to manage both projects to allow for the projects to be completed in a timely and financially responsible

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manner; and

- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby includes the water and wastewater treatment project under the Construction Management Team.
- IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby delegates the following additional duties, responsibilities and authorities to the Construction Management Team (*CMT*):
- A. Meetings. The CMT will meet with the engineers developing the water and waste water system on a weekly basis;
- **B.** Supplier of Wastewater Treatment Equipment. The CMT will make all decisions regarding the selection of a supplier for the equipment and machinery necessary to supply the wastewater treatment plant.
- C. Wastewater Treatment Plant Approval. The Construction Management Team shall approve the plans for the wastewater treatment plant which will include soliciting input from the wastewater treatment operators employed at the Grand Traverse Band.
- **D.** Water System Responsibilities. The CMT will help facilitate the water system development which will include, but not be limited to, working with the FAA and Michigan Bureau of Aeronautics.
