RESOLUTION NO. 01-03-07-01

Roads Training and Planning Contract

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a need for a Tribal Road system with funding support from the Bureau of Indian Affairs, and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funding available for Tribal roads Training and planning, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to accept a contract proposal from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist the Tribe in roads training and planning
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to accept a contract from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist the Tribe in Roads Training and Planning
