### **Long Range Transportation Planning**

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a need for long-range transportation planning, and

WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funding available for long-range transportation planning, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist the Tribe in long-range transportation planning

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to apply for a grant from the Bureau of Indian Affairs to assist the Tribe in long-range transportation planning
