Ottawa Language Preservation Program ANA Grant Application

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The culture and language of the people of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is very important to us as a people, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has conducted a Language Survey and determined that a large segment of our membership desire to learn our native language, and
- WHEREAS, The Administration for Native Americans has funding that can be used for developing a program that can assist us in the preservation of our language, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Administration of Native Americans to assist us in the preservation of our language
