Approving Cancellation of the March 28, 2001 Tribal Council Meeting

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has set the regular meeting dates to be scheduled every Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. and every third Saturday at 10:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Wednesday, March 28, 2001, is an official holiday of the Tribe, "Treaty Recognition Day;" and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that recognizing and honoring the holidays of the Tribe are as important as designating such date in remembrance of the activity; and

WHEREAS, it is required in section 4.01(c)(1) of the Tribal Council Meeting Procedures Ordinance, that regular meetings be canceled by action in the form of a resolution,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby cancels the March 28, 2001 regular Tribal Council meeting to allow Councilors to remember and honor the treaties of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians on Treaty Recognition Day.
