RESOLUTION NO. 01-03-21-02

U.S.D.A. RURAL DEVELOPMENT PRE APPLICATION FOR SECTION 515 RURAL RENTAL HOUSING NEW CONSTRUCTION LOAN

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band has a severe shortage of housing for our membership And are seeking ways to relieve this severe housing shortage, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has found that funding is available for new construction loans through the U.S.D.A. Section 515 Rural Rental Housing Loan Program, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to apply for a Section 515 Rural Rental Housing Loan Program through the U.S.D.A. to build 12 rental units

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a pre application for the U.S.D.A. Rural Development Section 515 Rural Rental Housing New Construction Loan to build 12 rental units to assist our membership with housing.
