Resolution # <u>OI-O3-QI-IO</u> Adopting Budget and Appropriation Ordinance, Ordinance # 01-100-04

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, under authority delegated in Article IV, Sections 1 and 7(i), and Article V, Section 5(a)(6) and Section 5(c) of the Constitution has developed an ordinance outlining the processes and time lines regarding adoption of a budget; and
- WHEREAS, this Ordinance requires hearings for the purposes of obtaining input from the membership to be scheduled by the Tribal Council and the Tribal Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, this Ordinance identifies deadlines for presentation of drafts and information to various parties and entities for review and comment, prior to final adoption; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has presented this Ordinance to the membership for review at its legislative sessions on February 22nd and March 17th; and

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby adopt the <u>Budget and Appropriations Ordinance</u> for immediate implementation; and

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby amends section 4.02 for purposes of Fiscal Year 2002 to require the Tribal Council to hold its membership input hearing during the month of April.
