WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT GRANT PRE APPLICATION

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a responsibility to protect the waters of our reservation, and
- WHEREAS, The Environmental Protection Agency has funding available for testing and collecting data on the water quality on the lakes, rivers, and streams of the reservation
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a pre application for a grant to the Environmental Protection Agency for a water quality management program for 2002
