SPECIAL DIABETES PROJECT GRANT

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has identified a prevalence of diabetes and diabetic related complications in the Tribal membership, and


WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has funding to assist in diabetic treatment, education and documentation , and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to apply for funding to assist in this effort for our membership


