SPECIAL DIABETES PROJECT GRANT

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has identified a prevalence of diabetes and diabetic related complications in the Tribal membership, and
- WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has funding to assist in diabetic treatment, education and documentation, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to apply for funding to assist in this effort for our membership
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Indians Health Service for a special diabetes project
