- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has an interest in protection of the environment in which we all live, and
- WHEREAS, The Environmental Protection Agency has special funding to assist the Little River Band in the protection of the quality of air in our area, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to apply for funding to assist in this effort for our membership
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Environmental Protection Agency to assist in the reduction of emission-based pollution in our area
