Approval of Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Aki Maad Zi Win Final Site Selection For Residential Housing

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission has approved the Residential Housing Site Selection by motion at the April 10th meeting as the Dontz Road site, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission wishes to submit this site selection to the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council for approval

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution formally approves the recommendation of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission selection of the Dontz Road property as the site for the Tribal Residential Housing Site
