RESOLUTION NO. 01-04-25-01

ADMINISTRATION ON NATIVE AMERICANS TRIBAL CENSUS GRANT APPLICATION

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a need to develop a data base of information on the Tribal membership through a Tribal Census, and
- WHEREAS, The Administration on Native Americans has funding available for grants to develop a Tribal Census and the Little River Band is eligible to apply for such a grant

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution formally approves the submission of a grant application to the Administration on Native Americans to conduct a Tribal Census.
