RESOLUTION NO. 01-04-25-01

ADMINISTRATION ON NATIVE AMERICANS TRIBAL CENSUS GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a need to develop a data base of information on the Tribal membership through a Tribal Census, and

WHEREAS, The Administration on Native Americans has funding available for grants to develop a Tribal Census and the Little River Band is eligible to apply for such a grant

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution formally approves the submission of a grant application to the Administration on Native Americans to conduct a Tribal Census.
