RESOLUTION NO. 01-04-25-03

Approval of Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Aki Madiiziwin Phase One of Dontz Road Housing Project

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission has approved the Aki Madiiziwin Phase One of the Dontz Road Housing Project, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Housing Commission wishes to submit this thirty five lot portion of our Housing Plan for the Dontz Road Property as Phase One of our plan for approval by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution formally approves Phase One of the Aki Madiiziwin Dontz Road Housing Project that will develop thirty five lots for 15 units of Elderly Housing and 12 units of Section 515 subsidized housing units.
