RESOLUTION NO. 01-04-25-06

Approval of Location for Little River Station Store, A Tribally owned Gas Station/Convenience Store

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council pursuant to Article IV, 7 of the Constitution has the power to enact ordinances and resolutions to promote the general welfare of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has determined that it is the best interest for the Economic Development and Well Being of Tribal Members to locate the Little River Station Store, a Tribally owned Gas Station/Convenience Store at the Little River Casio Resort Site.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution does hereby authorize the location of the Southwest corner of M22 and Dontz Rd (417 ft. frontage on M22 and 400 ft. frontage on Dontz Rd., for a total of 16,680 sq. ft., as the location for the Little River Station Store, a Tribally owned Gas Station/Convenience Store.
