LITTLE RIVER BAND OF OTTAWA INDIANS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS. The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is building a Wastewater Treatment Plant and is in need of a Maintenance and operations plan for that plant to assure that it will be maintained and operated properly, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has developed a Wastewater Treatment Plant Maintenance and Operations Plan

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution approves the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Wastewater Treatment Plant Maintenance and Operations Plan.
