### Supporting the Michigan Grand Council of the People of the Three Fires in Scheduling and Sharing Costs of Michigan Legislative Forums

WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a Member fo the Michigan Grand Council of the People of the Three Fires; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Grand Council of the People of the Three Fires met with Michigan Legislators to bring issues of concern and to educate new Michigan Legislators regarding Tribes and Tribal/State Relationships; and

WHEREAS, the Michigan Grand Council of the People of the Three Fires has adopted a Resolution which calls for the scheduling of a total of Four Forums in the Year 2001, along with Sponsors to arrange for those Meetings; and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to Support and Participate in these Meetings,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby Supports the Michigan Grand Council of the People of the Three Fires in Scheduling and Sharing Costs for those Legislative Forums
