### Bureau of Indian Affairs Housing Improvement Program FY 2001

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has established a need for funding from the Bureau of Indian Affairs for Housing Improvement, and
- WHEREAS, The Bureau of Indian Affairs has funding for a Housing Improvement Program to fund services to repair or renovate housing for the neediest of Indian families, living in substandard housing or who are without housing and have no other recourse for assistance

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council by this resolution formally requests a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the amount of \$105,000 for the Bureau of Indian Affairs Housing Improvement Program.

### CERTIFICATION OF ADOPTION
