RESOLUTION NO. 01-06-13-

ON THE THUNDERBIRD TRAIL MATCHING GRANT

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has an interest in protection of the environment in which we all live, and
- WHEREAS, The Turner Foundation has special funding to assist with matching funds to assist Little River Band in the protection of the quality of air in our area through our proposed On the Thunderbird Trail project, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to apply for funding to the Turner Foundation for a matching grant to assist in this effort for our membership
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Turner Foundation for a \$16,000 "On the Thunderbird Trail" matching grant to assist in the reduction of emission-based pollution in our area.
