RESOLUTION NO. 01-06-13-07

Contract With James McClurken to Transcribe and Edit Tapes of James Pego

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians seeks to document Tribal oral history, and


WHEREAS, James C. Pego has been identified as an Elder who is familiar with many of the historical facts about the Little River Band and has put this information on tape, and

WHEREAS, James McClurken who is a noted historian has the ability to transcribe these tapes and edit them into book form for a fee not to exceed \$5,000


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution authorizes a contract between James McClurken and the Tribe to transcribe and edit the tapes of James C. Pego for a fee not to exceed \$5,000 and by this resolution authorizes the Ogema to sign a contract with Mr. McClurken for this service.
