

## Little River Band of Ottawa Indians 1762 U.S. 31 South Manistee MI 49660 (231) 723-8288

Resolution No. #01-0627- <u>03</u>

Authorizing the Construction Management Team to Execute Change Order No. 18 for work related to the Wastewater Treatment Plant which changes the Agreement with VEC Engineering PLLC to include both (1) geotechnical and hydrogelologic study/work for the Wastewater Treatment Plant due to change of site (at a cost of \$12,500.00) and (2) architectural design services (through the services of Design Plus at a cost of \$19,500.00 plus anticipated expenses in the amount of \$1,600.00) at a total cost of \$33,600.00.

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has determined that the development of the permanent casino/resort facilities is in the best, long-term interests of the Tribe and its members: and

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- WHEREAS, the Tribe has pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0110-03, created a Construction Management Team to manage the construction of the Permanent Casino/Resort project under the Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0303-01, approved a Capital Budget for the Little River Casino Resort Expansion, which budget included a Contingency Allowance in the amount of \$2,700,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, Section D.4.d. of Resolution No. #01-0110-03 requires the Construction Management Team to present Change Orders to the Agreement, which either: (a) increase the Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Project prescribed in Agreements; or (b) would require use of any portion of the Contingency Allowance in the capital budget for the Project; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council is authorized to manage funds within the exclusive control of the Band, pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized by the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, the Construction Management Team and the Owner's Representative have presented, and are recommending approval of a Change Order for the additional work indicated, which would increase the Project cost by \$33,600.00 and which would be paid from the Contingency Allowance in the Capital Budget.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves Change Order No. 18 and authorizes the Construction Management Team to execute such Change Order with VEC Engineering for work related to the Wastewater Treatment Plant which changes the Agreement with VEC Engineering PLLC to include both (1) additional expenses related to geotechnical and hydrogelologic study/work for the Wastewater Treatment Plant due to change of site (at a cost of \$12,500.00) and (2) architectural design services (through Design Plus at a cost of \$19,500.00 plus \$1,600.00 in anticipated reimbursable expenses) for a total cost of \$33,600.00.
