## BAY ENERGY SERVICES INC. CONTRACT

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has identified a need to establish a comprehensive renewable energy public utility plan, and
- WHEREAS, Bay Energy Service Inc. can provide the services needed by the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by producing a comprehensive renewable energy public utility plan

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Ogema to sign a contract between the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians and the Bay Energy Services, Inc. in the amount of \$7,600 to produce a Comprehensive Renewable Energy Public Utility Plan for the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians.
