DESIGN PLUS INC. CONTRACT

- HEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is planning a gas station and convenience store to be located near the Little River Casino, and
- WHEREAS, There is a need for architectural, mechanical, and electrical working drawings to be developed by an architectural firm, and
- WHEREAS, After reviewing five bids for working drawings from five architectural firms and finding that Design Plus Inc. has presented the bid deemed acceptable for this project
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution authorizes the Tribal Ogema to sign a contract with Design Plus Inc. to produce working drawings for our Tribal Gas Station Project in the amount of \$41,500
