WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AND PLANNING GRANT

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is deeply involved in protecting the environment in which we live in protecting the air, land and water quality of our area, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band is operating a Water Quality Grant from the EPA to study the water quality of the Manistee River Watershed, and




