## RESOLUTION NO. 01-08-08-0

## FY2002 INDIAN HOUSING PLAN/BLOCK GRANT (IHBG)

- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, And
- WHEREAS, the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, Section 102 of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) requires the submission of a housing plan for guiding and accomplishing housing activities to meet community needs; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, pursuant to Resolution No. #98-0618-01, designated the Little River Housing Commission as the Tribally-Designated Housing Entity for purposes of administering housing programs under NAHASDA and authorized the Housing Commission to submit the 1 and 5 year Housing Plans to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) on behalf of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the Little River Housing Commission has presented its Housing Plan to the Tribal Council for review prior to submission of that Plan to HUD; and
- WHEREAS, there are funds available from HUD to met this need according to the Little River Indian Housing Plan (IHP) attached; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to request that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, approve the Little River Band NAHASDA Indian Housing Plan and award of Block Grant funds in the amount of \$387,310.00 to carry out the FY 2002 Little River Indian Housing Plan.
