RESOLUTION NO. 01-08-15-01

TRIBAL MANAGEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has identified a need to strengthen the Tribe's health management structure, and

WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has funding available that can be used for this purpose in the Tribal Management Grant Program

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a grant proposal to the Indian Health Service for a Tribal Management Grant in the amount of \$50,000.
