- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has identified a need for energy assistance for our membership, and
- WHEREAS, The Department of Health and Human Services Office of Family
 Assistance has funding available to assist Low Income Native American
 People with energy needs through the Low Income Home Energy
 Assistance Program

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution wishes to submit a grant request to the Department of Health and Human Services for a Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
