- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council has accepted an invitation from the Walking Shield American Indian Society to participate in the FY-2003 Operation Walking Shield Program, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has an opportunity to participate in medical and dental services from the military as a result of the acceptance of this invitation, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band has agreed to provide a grant of \$20,000 for food and lodging for the military medical and dental team during their stay on the Little River Band Reservation

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution allocates \$20,000 from the Tribe's General Fund as a grant to the Walking Shield American Indian Society to provide funding for military medical and dental personnel during their stay on the Little River Band Reservation for Operation Walking Shield 2003.
