Resolution #01-1219-

Authorizing the Construction Management Team to Execute a Change Order that amends the contract amount with Cameron Brothers to reflect an increase of \$5,714.24 as per Indian Health Service. (It should be noted that this Change Order involves the tax-exempt side of the overall project and it does not involve Cunningham-Limp.)

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. '1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under article IV, Section 7 to "exercise the inherent powers of the Little River Band by establishing laws and through the enactment of ordinances and adoptions of resolutions not inconsistent with this Constitution... to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has determined that the development of the permanent casino/resort facilities is in the best, long-term interests of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe had previously entered into an agreement with Cameron Brothers for work related to the Community Water and Wastewater Systems; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0110-03, created a Construction Management Team to manage the construction of the Permanent Casino-Resort project under the above Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of Indian Health Services that the costs for the installation of the submersible pumps related to the Water System be covered by a Change Order; with the associated costs applied to the tax-exempt loan, i.e, to the Water System budget in the amount of \$5,714.24; and
- WHEREAS, Section D.4d of Resolution No. 01-0110-03 requires the Construction Management Team to present Change Orders to the Agreement, which either: (a) increase the Guaranteed Maximum Price for the project prescribed in the Agreement; or 9b) would require use of any portion of the Contingency Allowance in the capital budget for the project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council is authorized to manage funds within the exclusive control of the Band, pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Management Team and the Owner's Representative have presented and are recommending approval of a Change Order to the Corvette Construction Contract in an amount of \$5,714.24 which would be paid from the tax-exempt loan.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves by Resolution the Change Order associated with Cameron Brothers' work on the Community Water and Wastewater Treatment Systems as described in the correspondence from Indian Health Services for additional costs not in the original scope of work in an amount of \$5,714.24.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema or, in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, to execute the above mentioned Change Order.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council authorizes an increase in the contract with Cameron Brothers in the amount of \$5,714.24 and authorized payment through the tax-exempt loan to fund the costs of this work.


