Resolution No. #01-1219-20

Approving the Fiscal Year 2002 Tribal Government Operating Budget and Acceptance of the Budget Narratives

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council, pursuant to Article IV, 7(i)(1) of the Constitution, has the power, subject to veto of the Tribal Ogema, to approve the annual budget presented by the Tribal Ogema and to authorize the expenditure of funds in accordance with such budgets; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Ogema has in accordance with Section 4.08 of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, Ordinance No. 01-100-04, presented the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget, in the form required by Section 4.06 of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance; and
- WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget document presented by the Tribal Ogema includes a narrative section, required under Section 4.06(b) of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, describing the functional responsibilities and objectives for each subdivision of the Tribal government, together with estimated expenditures for such objectives; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has, prior to submission of the final Fiscal Year 2002 Budget document, reviewed the proposed Fiscal Year 2002 budget and the narrative portions of the budget and made amendments as determined necessary; and

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oputing ladget of WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget reflects total revenues to the Tribal Government of \$33,251,178.00, including total distributions from gaming operations in the amount amount of 12,000,000, and total expenditures of 33,251,178.00, including capital contributions to Tribal enterprises; \$6,500,000.00 in equity contributions to the expansion of Little River Casino Resort, retaining an estimated \$5,215,676.00 in reserve, and \$2,000,000.00 in contributions to investment accounts; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council wishes to approve the proposed Fiscal Year 2002 budget and accept the narrative portions of the budget to be implemented on January 1, 2002.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby adopts and approves the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget presented by the Tribal Ogema in accordance with Section 4.08 of the Budget and Appropriations Ordinance.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council accepts the narrative portions of the Fiscal Year 2002 Budget document, as identified in Attachment 1 to this resolution.

IT IS FINALLY RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council directs the Fiscal Year 2002 Operating Budget narratives shall be a confidential, non-public document which may not be released or viewed without approval of the Tribal Council.
