CONSULTANT CONTRACT WITH MEAGAN KEMPF FOR LRBOI CENSUS

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band has identified a need for a census and have received a grant from The Administration On Native Americans to conduct a census, and
- WHEREAS, This grant identified Ms. Meagan Kemp as a consultant who could assist the Tribe in development of a census instrument, provide training to employees and serve as consultant in overseeing the development of the Census Project and will analyze and summarize the findings

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Ogema to negotiate and enter into a contract with Ms. Meagan Kemp for an amount not to exceed \$5,000.
