
**SUBMISSION OF A TITLE VI ELDERS NUTRITION GRANT BY THE  
INTER-TRIBAL COUNCIL OF MICHIGAN**


- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is a member of the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan, and
- WHEREAS, The Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan wishes to submit a grant for a Title VI Elders Nutrition Grant on behalf of the member Tribes of the Michigan Inter-Tribal Council

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the submission of a Title VI Elders Nutrition Grant to the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Administration on Aging by the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan.
