CONSULTANT CONTRACT WITH VANESSA BUHS FOR ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band has been awarded two Indian Development Community Block Grants (ICDBG) in the amount of \$1,000,000. A requirement of the grant prior to spending funds is to complete an environmental study and publish a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), and
- WHEREAS, Vanessa Buhs has completed environmental reviews of this type in the past and will work in conjunction with Dawn Cornelius, Environmentalist of the Conservation Department to complete this review.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes the Tribal Ogema to negotiate and enter into a contract with Ms. Vanessa Buhs for an amount not to exceed \$1,400 to be paid by through the Casino Expansion Budget (Administration line) as this work directly benefits this project.
