Approving Cancellation of the April 20, 2002 Tribal Council Meeting

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. §1300k et seq.)(hereinafter "Little River Act"); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has set the regular meeting dates to be scheduled every Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. and every third Saturday at 10:00 a.m.; and
- WHEREAS, on April 20, 2002 there is scheduled both a Tribal Council meeting and a Membership Meeting by the Tribal Ogema; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has determined that the Membership Meeting scheduled by the Tribal Ogema is a priority; and
- WHEREAS, it is required in section 4.01(c)(1) of the <u>Tribal Council Meeting Procedures</u> Ordinance, that regular meetings be canceled by action in the form of a resolution,
- NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby cancels the April 20, 2002 regular Tribal Council meeting to allow Councilors to attend the Membership Meeting scheduled by the Tribal Ogema.
