APPROVAL OF ADDITION TO THE I.H.S. CONTRACT FOR 2002

- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and
- WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians is attempting to document information on Tribal members who are diabetic, and
- WHEREAS, The Indian Health Services has funding available to assist in this effort and this funding may be added to the existing 2002 contract between the I.H.S. and the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that by this resolution the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians Tribal Council authorizes amending the I.H.S. Contract with the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians to add \$49,032.00 to assist the Tribe with documenting information on Tribal Diabetics..
