INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE SELF-GOVERNANCE PLANNING GRANT

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has a long and proud history as a Nation which pre-dates the establishment of the government of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians was a signatory of the Treaty of Washington of March 28, 1836 and the Treaty of Detroit of July 31, 1855 with the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians status as a federally-recognized Tribe was reaffirmed and restored by the United States Congress in Public Law 103-324, and

WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians has established a strong government and is developing strong internal systems, and


WHEREAS, The Little River Band of Ottawa Indians wishes to prepare Tribal systems for operation under Self-Governance with the Indian Health Service by applying for a Self-Governance planning grant, and

WHEREAS, The Indian Health Service has funding available to assist Tribes in Self-Governance planning through Self-Governance Planning Grants


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians by this resolution authorizes submission of a Self-Governance Planning Grant in the amount of \$50,000 to the Indian Health Service.
