Resolution #02-0306-05

Authorizing the Construction Management Team to Execute Bulletin No. 45 to Execute Change Order to add water meters at the Casino domestic water riser and Hotel Domestic water riser, NOT provided in the base contract scope of work at a cost of \$11,220.00

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. '1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under article IV, Section 7 to "exercise the inherent powers of the Little River Band by establishing laws and through the enactment of ordinances and adoptions of resolutions not inconsistent with this Constitution...to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members"; and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has determined that the development of the permanent casino/resort facilities is in the best, long-term interests of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0303-02, authorized the execution of a Design/Build Agreement, dated March 1, 2001, with Cunningham-Limp Company for the design and construction of the Tribe's permanent Casino-Resort; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0110-03, created a Construction Management Team to manage the construction of the Permanent Casino-Resort project under the above Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0303-01, approved a Capital Budget for the Little River Casino Resort Expansion, which budget included a contingency allowance in the amount of \$2,700,000.00; and
- WHEREAS, Section D.4d of Resolution No. 01-0110-03 requires the Construction Management Team to present Change Orders to the Agreement, which either: (a) increase the Guaranteed Maximum Price for the project prescribed in the Agreement; or 9b) would require use of any portion of the Contingency Allowance in the capital budget for the project; and

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 7 (i)(2) of the Tribal Constitution, the Tribal Council is authorized to manage funds within the exclusive control of the Band, pursuant to appropriations or budgets authorized by the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Construction Management Team and the Owner's Representative presented and recommended approval of Bulletin 45 for additional work, which required approval by resolution and authorizes the execution of a Change Order to increase the Project cost by \$11,220.00 which would be paid from the Contingency Allowance in the Capital Budget.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves by Resolution Bulletin 45 and which further authorizes the Construction Management Team to process a Change Order to add water meters at the Casino domestic water riser and Hotel Domestic water riser, NOT provided in the Base Scope of Work at the cost of \$11,220.00.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema or, in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, to sign the Change Order that incorporates the changes in Bulletin 45.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council authorizes an incremental increase in the guaranteed maximum price in the Agreement (with Cunningham-Limp) in the amount of \$11,220.00 and authorizes use of the Contingency Allowance in the Capital Budget, as necessary, to fund the cost of such incremental work.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION

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Provide and install two (2) 4" Compound Water Meters with +/- 1.0% accuracy from 3/4 GPM to 800 GPM. Maximum flow rate for the Hotel or Casino should be 400 GPM or less. Pressure drop for this 4" meter at 400 GPM is less than 2 psig. Included with these meters is an inline strainer. We have also included a three (3) valve bypass for both meters.

Note: Turbine Meters are much less accurate at low flows from 0 to 20 gpm
