Resolution #02-0403-

Authorizing the Tribal Ogema, or in the absence of, the Tribal Council Speaker to sign the Change Order as recommended by the Construction Management Team for changes made to the original pump and electrical specifications for the pump house per John Anderson, IHS, which will be completed by Davis Construction Company at a cost not to exceed \$6,967.00

- WHEREAS, the Tribe's status as a federally-recognized Indian tribe was reaffirmed and restored by Congress pursuant to Public Law 103-324, 108 Stat. 2156 (25 U.S.C. '1300k et seq.); and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe adopted a new Constitution, pursuant to a vote of the membership on May 27, 1998, which Constitution became effective upon its approval by the Assistant Secretary-Indian Affairs on July 10, 1998; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is authorized under article IV, Section 7 to "exercise the inherent powers of the Little River Band by establishing laws and through the enactment of ordinances and adoptions of resolutions not inconsistent with this Constitution...to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Little River Band and its members"; and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has determined that the development of the permanent casino/resort facilities is in the best, long-term interests of the Tribe and its members; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has executed a tax exempt loan agreement with Miller-Schroeder to cover the costs of the community water and wastewater treatment systems and additionally contracted with Davis Construction Company for the Phase II work related to the construction of both the pump house and wastewater treatment facility; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has, pursuant to Resolution No. #01-0110-03, created a Construction Management Team to manage the construction of these project elements with the assistance of the Owner's Representative; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe has approved tax exempt financing and an approved budget for the community water and wastewater treatment systems; and
- WHEREAS, the Construction Management Team and the Owner's Representative have reviewed this consideration and recommending approval of the additional work

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council of the Little River Band of Ottawa Indians hereby approves the additional work by NETCOM by Resolution and which further authorizes the Construction Management Team to process a Change Order to provide electrical prep work at bus drop off for future third cage, NOT provided for in the Project's Base Scope of Work at the cost of \$23,204.00.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Ogema or, in his absence, the Tribal Council Speaker, to sign the Change Order related to the additional work through NETCOM that was not in their original scope of work and authorizes the use of the Contingency Allowance in the FF&E budget in an amount not to exceed \$23,204.00 for this work.
